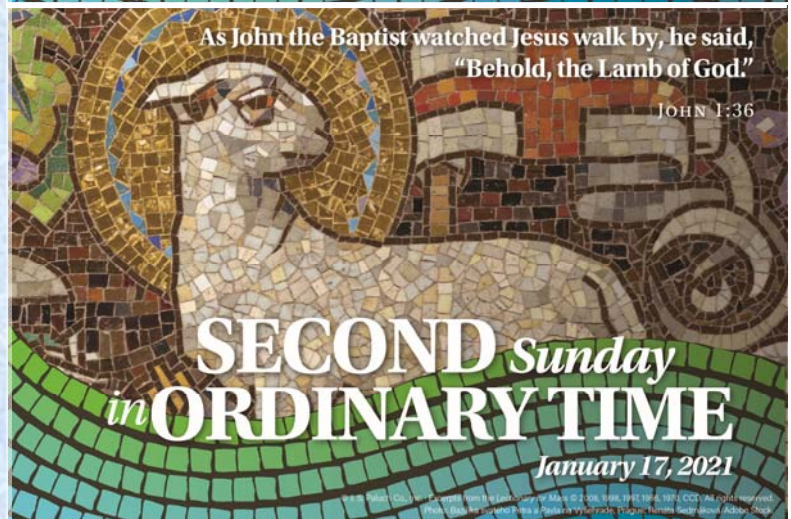

SPEAK, LORD, WE ARE LISTENING

In today's first reading God keeps calling out in the night to a sleeping boy. Neither the boy, Samuel, nor his teacher, Eli, understands who is calling. But God's persistence convinces them. Samuel is then ready—not ready yet to do anything, but ready to listen. "Speak, for your servant is listening" (1 Samuel 3:10).

In the Gospel Jesus is out teaching. Various people notice him and begin to gather around. They soon become disciples and, like the young Samuel, are ready—not ready yet to do anything, but ready to listen. "Speak," they say, "we are listening."

God's voice is always with us, awake or asleep. It swirls around us like fog on a waterfront, enveloping us, gently urging us to wake up, to listen. Awareness of the voice comes first; then willingness to listen; then, in time, the decision to act, to live according to God's word. Let's ask today for the ability to keep our ears open so we don't miss God's voice.

Vamos a pedir hoy por la capacidad de mantener los oídos abiertos para que no se pierda la voz de Dios.

St. Barnabas Church Is Now In The Loop!

A wonderful feature available on many hearing aids is called the "telecoil". It's also referred to as a "t-switch" or "t-coil". It's

nothing more than a tiny coil of wire around a core that will induce an electric current in the coil when it's in the presence of a changing magnetic field.

A telecoil, can therefore, be an alternate or supplemental input device for a hearing aid. Normally, a hearing aid "listens" with its microphone, then amplifies what it "hears". But with a telecoil used as the input source instead of (or in addition to) the microphone, the hearing aid can "hear" a magnetic signal which represents sound. St. Barnabas church is now equipped to allow those with T-Coil equipped hearing aids to take advantage of this technology and enjoy the benefits of enhanced and clearer sound. Signing Up for Weekend Masses

In accordance with NC and Diocesan Covid-19 guidelines, Mass attendance is limited to help mitigate the spread of the virus. At St. Barnabas Catholic Church we feel it is more welcoming to have people sign up in advance for Masses rather than turning people away at the door after maximum capacity is reached. Here are some things that will help you in the sign-up process:

- If you try to sign up and the page is "locked", that means someone else is signing up at the same time. Wait a few moments and try again.
- We cannot admit people who are not signed up, and we ask your cooperation in making the job of our Greeters easier by not coming if you are not signed up.
- If you are not able to sign up, we encourage you to view Mass on our youtube channel.

We are grateful to be able to celebrate Masses together in person during the pandemic, and we ask your help and cooperation in maintaining a safe environment to do so.
