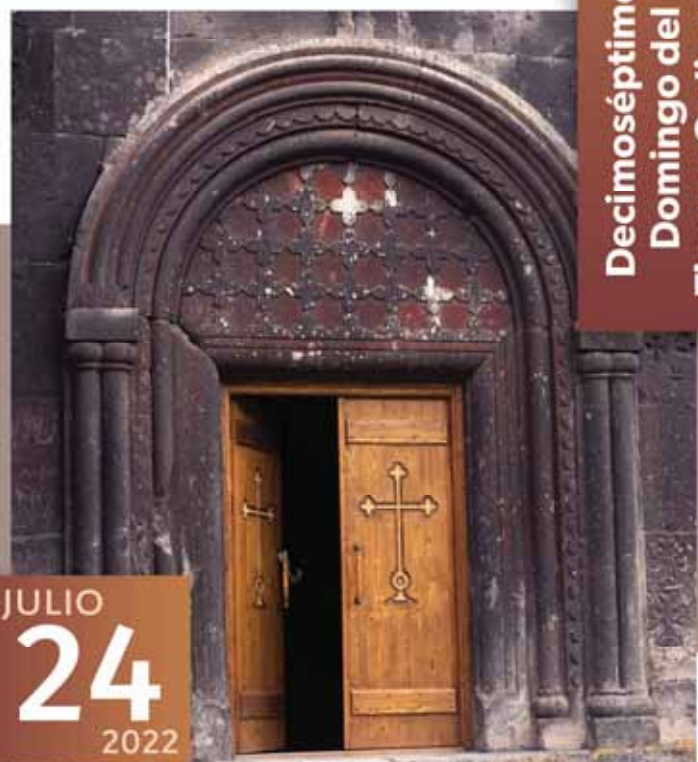

THE SACRAMENT OF FIRST CONFESSION AND FIRST HOLY

COMMUNION - Second grade is the normal time. One year prior Religious Education is required.

THE SACRAMENT OF HOLY ORDERS - Men should call the parish priest or the Diocesan Vocation Director to help them discern their call to the Diaconate or Priesthood.

THE SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY - Couples should make an appointment with the priest or deacon at the time of engagement and at least six months in advance of any wedding date to begin preparations. No date should be set before that meeting so all canonical requirements are met. One party must be registered at our church and an active Catholic. All weddings take place inside the Church.

THE SACRAMENT OF THE ANOINTING OF SICK - The anointing of the sick can be administered to anyone suffering from a serious or chronic illness. Please call the church office to make arrangements to be anointed. In an emergency, please use ext. 1, leave a message with your name and phone number. You will be contacted as soon as possible.

Faith Formation and SoE Youth Ministry

Registration for 2022-2023: Registration opens July 30th online, with optional in-person help in the evenings of August 16-18 from 6:30-8:00pm. Please register by August 21st to receive our early bird rate which gives our staff time to get classes together and our



catechists to accurately prepare for the first session on **September 11th**, which is the final cut-off date for registration. In order to register for Faith Formation or SoE, families must both be registered in the parish and attending Mass here regularly, as opposed to attending at a different parish or not attending Mass at all. This regular, weekly attendance here is an important part of being involved in our parish life. As formation in the faith is more than just for Sacramental formation, for any child to be registered, all children in the home must be either registered for Faith Formation here or have a clear alternative in place which is communicated to the DRE.

Ongoing Stewardship Option for Faith

Formation: Starting this year, families registering for Faith Formation or Suns of Encouragement (SoE Youth Ministry) will be able to choose between paying a fee for the year or being involved in meeting a need of the parish through ongoing stewardship. Our registration form includes many options of stewardship to fit the talents and abilities of anyone.



The Purpose of Faith Formation and Youth Ministry:

We are here to assist you as parents in being the first and greatest teachers of your children, especially in the most important area of all: our Faith! Our goal is to help you discover in ever more deep and amazing ways the love and joy of being in a relationship with Jesus and each other through His Church. We need Jesus in our daily lives, and we also need Catholic friends who inspire a response of faith in us. This is true for all ages.

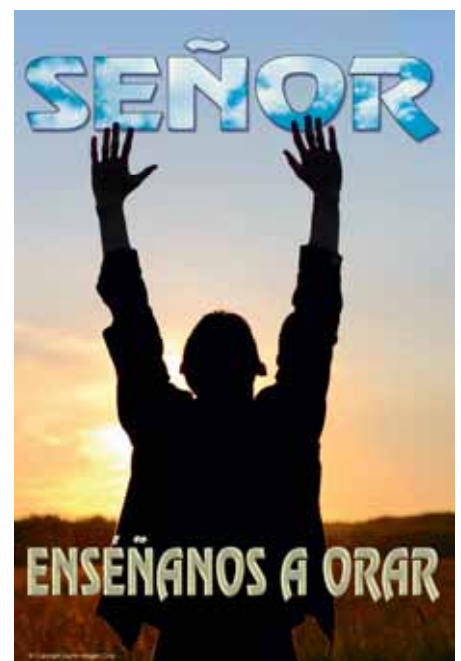

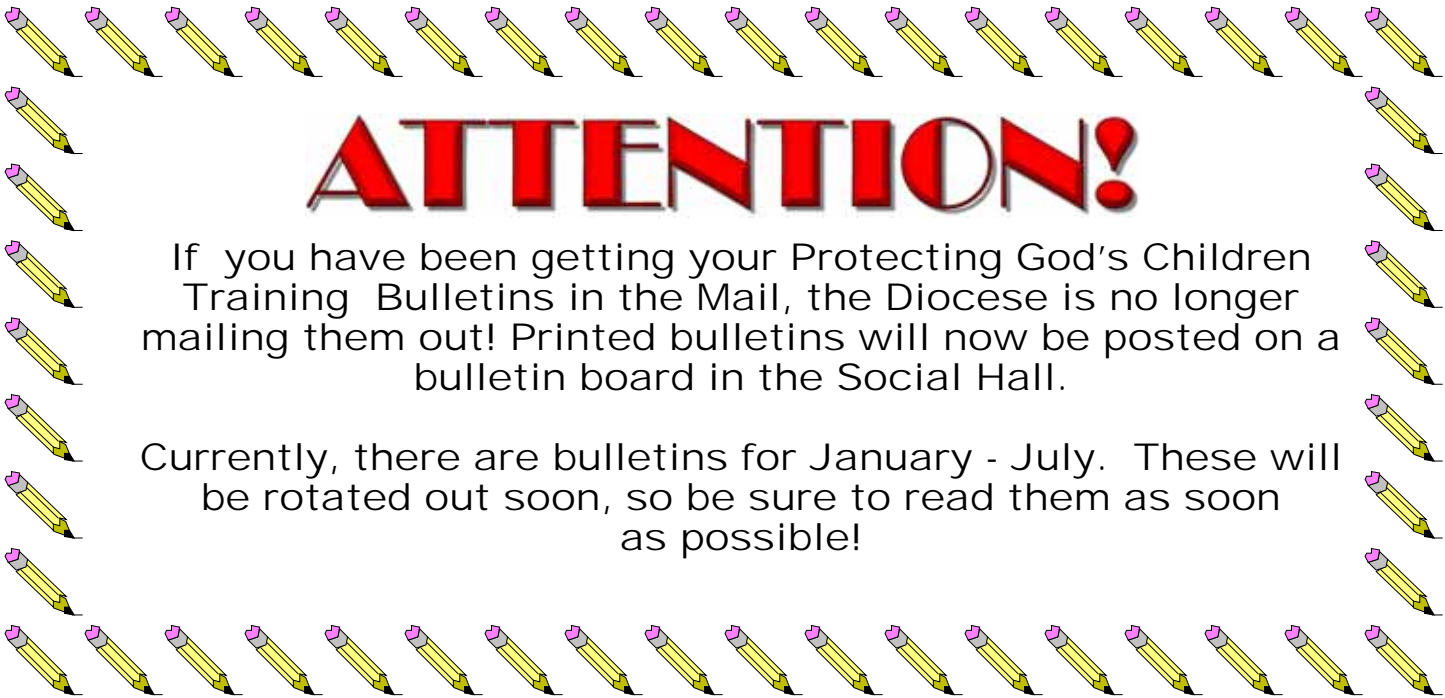

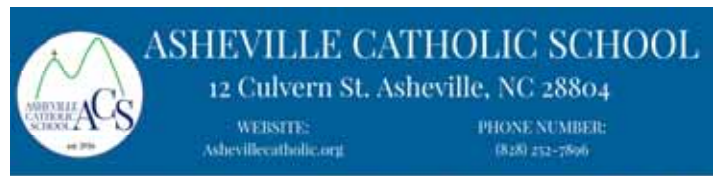

Meet our Neighbors

Most parishioners at St. Barnabas are very familiar with the St. Vincent de Paul Food Pantry. It is a very visible part of our ministry, serving between 45 and 55 families each week. We appreciate the generous support you have provided to help meet the needs of so many who are struggling with getting food.

The other work we do is less visible but equally vital. People in need call our line, 828-684-6098, ext 1308, with requests for help with rent, utilities, medical expenses, car expenses, and assorted other needs. We'd like to introduce you to one or two typical callers.

Many are single parent families, though many are two parent families. The adults work full-time, often have a second job as well. Their jobs tend to be at the bottom of the pay scale. Most people we work with have been able to meet their monthly needs but aren't able to put aside savings for a rainy day. When that rainy day happens, they find themselves in financial trouble. Maybe it's an unexpected illness that keeps one wage earner out of work – and their job has no sick time benefits. Or their car breaks down. Do you pay to fix the car

so you can get to work or do you pay your rent or electric bill? A pair of Vincentians visits the family, reviews their income and expenses, provides advice or referrals to such programs as On-Track, which helps people learn to budget. If the Vincentians judge the help needed to be viable, they present the case to the conference which then decides whether we can help the family and with how much. We do expect our neighbors to contribute as well. Our help is usually a bridge to get the family to the other side of a crisis so they can resume being self-sufficient, hopefully with increased knowledge of how to plan for a rainy day. While some of the people we help we do see every year or two, most of the people we serve in this way are with "one and done" visits and help. Some are able to improve their situations so much that they become donors to support our mission.

And so we greatly appreciate your support of this part of our mission as well. Thank you for all that you do, and especially for your prayers as we go forth to meet the needs of our neighbors in Christ.

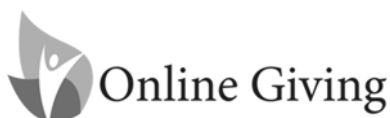
