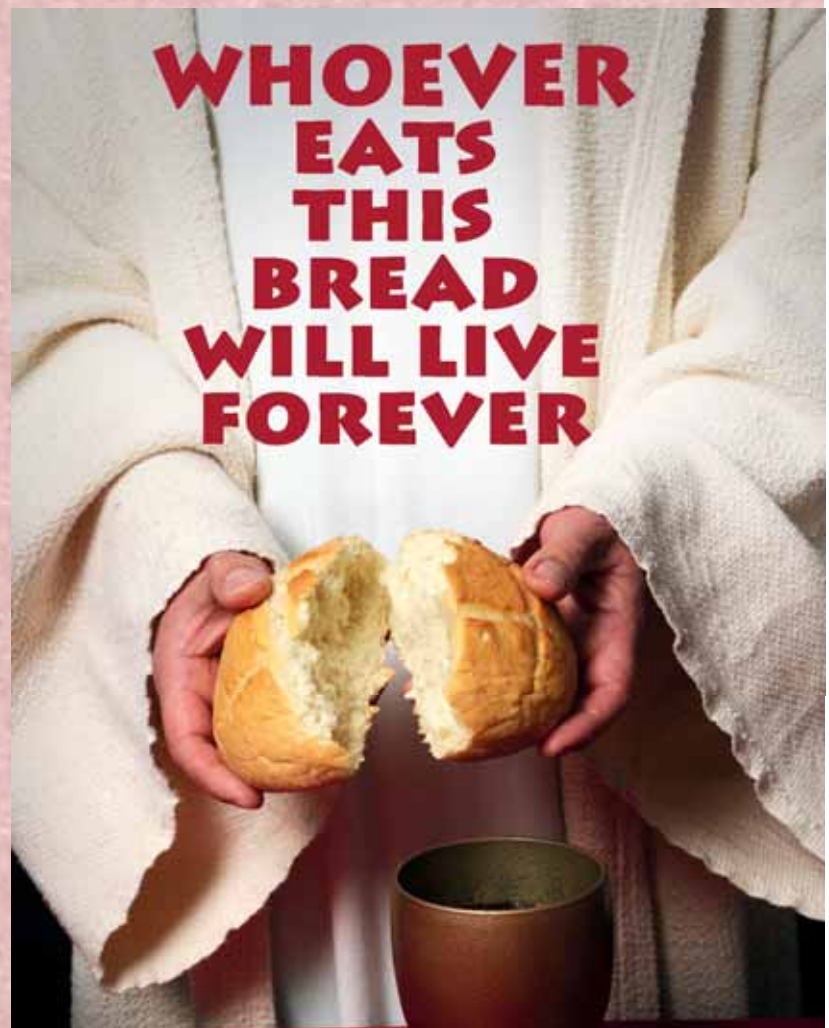

THE SACRAMENT OF HOLY ORDERS - Men should call the parish priest or the Diocesan Vocation Director to help them discern their call to the Diaconate or Priesthood.

THE SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY - Couples should make an appointment with the priest or deacon at the time of engagement and at least six months in advance of any wedding date to begin preparations. No date should be set before that meeting so all canonical requirements are met. One party must be registered and an active Catholic. All weddings take place inside the Church.

THE SACRAMENT OF THE ANOINTING OF SICK - The anointing of the sick can be administered to anyone suffering from a serious or chronic illness. Please call the church office to make arrangements to be anointed. In an emergency, please use ext. 1, leave a message with your name and phone number. You will be contacted as soon as possible.

FEAST OF FAITH

Sanctus, Sanctus, Sanctus: Song of Heaven

The words of the Sanctus are rooted in the scriptures. They recall the song of the seraphim in the prophet Isaiah's vision of God in majesty: "Seraphim were stationed above; each of them had six wings: with two they veiled their faces, with two they veiled their feet, and with two they hovered aloft. 'Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of hosts!' they cried one to the other. 'All the earth is filled with his glory!' " (Isaiah 6:2-3). They recall the Gospel accounts of Jesus' entry into Jerusalem: "Hosanna to the Son of David; blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord; hosanna in the highest" (Matthew 21:9). Yet the liturgy adds something new to these ancient texts. The seraphim sang, "the earth is filled with his glory." But the liturgy proclaims, "heaven and earth are full of your glory." In the Eucharist, earth and heaven meet. For a moment in time, we join in the song that the angels sing for all time. The Sanctus raises us to heaven, but does not remove us from the earth. It is the song of the King who took on our human flesh so that we might share in his divine life.

What is Apostolic Succession?

Have you ever considered the role of apostolic succession within the history of Holy Mother Church, and its place in the future? Apostolic

succession is the doctrine that the bishops of the Catholic Church perpetuate ordinations that go historically in succession to the Apostles of Christ. The Catholic Church can actually follow the line of each bishop right back to Jesus.



Jesus Christ gave His apostles His authority to carry to the world after His ascension. While on earth, Jesus taught them the Truth of faith, rooted in the Will of the Father, to be protected by the Holy Spirit. When Jesus appeared after the resurrection, He told His apostles:

“As the Father has sent Me, so I send you” (John 20:21).

“Whoever listens to you listens to Me. Whoever rejects you rejects Me. And whoever rejects Me rejects the One who sent Me” (Luke 10:16).

“Whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven” (Matthew 16:18; 18:18).

Peter and the others were only the first, not the last, not the only ones to carry out Christ’s authority. Those guys appointed others who spread the Truth, who appointed others, and others, and, etc. It is important to remember that the writing of the Church fathers are parallel to scripture, not separate. For example, St. Ignatius of Antioch

was a student of the apostle John. Ignatius learned from John all John had learned from Jesus. Ignatius taught that we should look upon the Bishop as if we are looking upon Christ, Himself. Why? Because the Bishops, particularly

the Bishop of Rome, has the distinct task of protecting, teaching, modeling the AUTHENTIC TEACHINGS of Jesus. Because these teachings are protected in this way, early Christians turned to those with Apostolic succession and the churches they established to determine the difference

between Truth and heresy. These Truths are held for us in the writings of the Church fathers, in the writings of the Popes, and in the Catechism. They are accessible to every Catholic seeking an answer.

The line of apostolic succession will continue into the future of the Church. Does that mean there has not been, or will never be Bishops that deviate from authentic teaching? Of course not! Facility Improvements and Maintenance update from the Parish Finance Council

During this past year our parish has been able to make the following facility improvements/maintenance through the generous contributions of our parishioners:

- ↗ Sanctuary renovation, which included new pews with increased handicapped seating, a hearing aid loop, new statues, the ability to live stream Masses, and more - \$350,000
- ↗ Installed air purifier system throughout the building for healthier air- \$11,500
- ↗ Pavilion area: tree removal and land improvements - \$6,500
- ↗ New rectory roof - \$13,500
- ↗ Installed backflow valve on city water line to bring up to code - \$14,000
- ↗ Updated lighting from fluorescent to LED in two areas of the building - \$6500
- ↗ And others...
