### THE SACRAMENT OF FIRST CONFESSION AND FIRST HOLY

**COMMUNION** - Second grade is the normal time. One year prior Religious Education is required.

**THE SACRAMENT OF HOLY ORDERS** - Men should call the parish priest or the Diocesan Vocation Director to help them discern their call to the Diaconate or Priesthood.

**THE SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY** - Couples should make an appointment with the priest or deacon at the time of engagement and at least six months in advance of any wedding date to begin preparations. No date should be set before that meeting so all canonical requirements are met. One party must be registered at our church and an active Catholic. All weddings take place inside the Church.

**THE SACRAMENT OF THE ANOINTING OF SICK** - The anointing of the sick can be administered to anyone suffering from a serious or chronic illness. Please call the church office to make arrangements to be anointed. In an emergency, please use ext. 1, leave a message with your name and phone number. You will be contacted as soon as possible.

#### Faith Formation and SoE Youth Ministry



**Registration for 2022-2023:** Registration opens July 30th online, with optional in-person help on Thursday, August 18 from 6:30

-8:00pm. Please register by August 21st to receive our early bird rate which gives our staff time to get classes together and our catechists to accurately prepare for the first session on **September 11th**, which is the final cut-off date for registration. In order to register for Faith Formation or SoE, families must both be registered in the parish and attending Mass here regularly, as opposed to attending at a different parish or not attending Mass at all. This regular, weekly attendance here is an important part of being involved in our parish life. As formation in the faith is more than just for Sacramental formation, for any child to be registered, all children in the home must be either registered for Faith Formation here or have a clear alternative in place which is communicated to the DRE.

#### Ongoing Stewardship Option for Faith Formation:

Starting this year, families registering for Faith Formation or Sons of Encouragement (SoE Youth Ministry) will be able to choose between paying a fee for the year or being involved in meeting a need of the parish through ongoing stewardship.

Our registration form includes many options of stewardship to fit the talents and abilities of anyone.



## PROPHETS

We reflect upon the voice of the prophet in this Sunday's readings. We hear of the suffering and the rescue of Jeremiah. We hear how Jesus anticipates his suffering and death. As with Jeremiah and Jesus, the prophets were sent by God to the leaders and people of Israel. A prophet is one who speaks truth to the powerful, exposing their darker hidden motives and injustices. The prophet presents a way forward that aligns with God's purposes. A prophet can force people away from a comfortable neutrality or indifference. The prophet creates an urgency to make a choice: Are we content with the status quo, or are we to change our ways and pursue a new and better path? Today, we may also ask, how do we identify and respond to prophets of our time? How might we provide a prophetic voice in our Church and in our world?

The novena prayer will be prayed at all masses from Aug. 18 until St. Monica's feast day August 27<sup>th</sup>, and her statue and a book for prayer requests will be on display in the church.

St. Monica (331 – 387) was a Christian in North Africa, married to an alcoholic pagan who refused to allow their children to be baptized. After many prayers, St. Monica's husband converted to Christianity before his death, and their two younger children entered religious life. Their oldest child Augustine, however, fell into a dissolute life, fathered an illegitimate child, and became a devotee of a popular heretical sect. After St. Monica's persistent prayer over many years, Augustine finally converted to Christianity, and eventually became a priest, bishop, saint and doctor of the Church! St. Monica is the patron saint of conversions, Christian mothers, difficult marriages, alcoholics and parents of wayward children. Her feast day is August 27<sup>th</sup>; her son St. Augustine's feast day is August 28<sup>th</sup>.

### The St. Monica novena prayer:

*"St. Monica, prayerful wife and mother, many sorrows grieved your heart throughout your life, yet you never gave in to despair or lost hope. With unwavering persistence and steadfast faith, you prayed fervently for the conversion of your troubled husband and for your beloved son, Augustine. God answered your tearful prayers. Grant me that same enduring patience and trust in the Lord. St. Monica, pray that God may listen to the cries of my heart and grant me that grace to embrace His Will for my life. All glory be to our Triune God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Amen."*

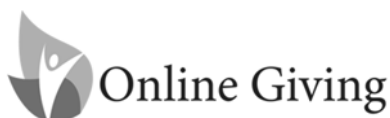
